Live Wrestling Exhibition

PLW will put on a 2 to 2 1/2 hour wrestling exhibition. PLW will provide the ring, public address equipment and talent (wrestlers, referees, ring announcer, etc.).



Flyers & Tickets

In the weeks before the show, PLW will provide flyers and tickets at no charge to your group.



Media Announcements

PLW will send out press releases to the local newspapers, television and radio stations.



Internet Coverage

PLW will post the information for the show on its website, and on other internet outlets which list upcoming wrestling events. On the PLW website, a description of the event and directions to the venue will be available.

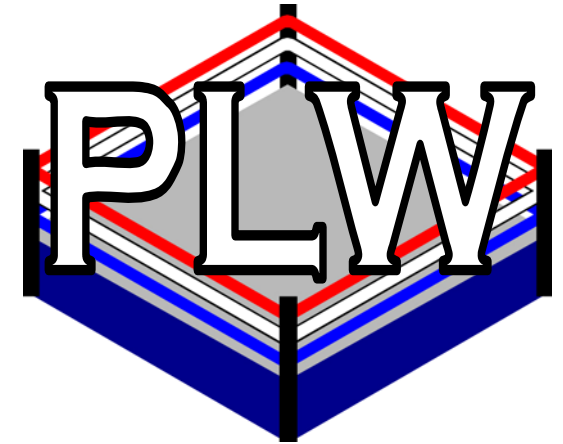
